Drain-Clear is a high strength alkaline product that breaks down grease that has built up on pipe surfaces. This allows hair and other clogging items to be flushed away. It can also be used as part of regular maintenance program.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE:

Blocked up drains:

Remove standing water, pour 250ml of Drain-Clear into drain, add 250ml of hot water and allow to stand for 10 minutes.

For larger drains use double quantity of Drain-Clear.

Slow running drains:

Mix half 250ml of Drain-Clear with one cup of hot water and pour into drain. Do not use drain for 5 minutes.

General Maintenance:

Add 250ml of Drain-Clear to hot water and pour down drain regularly.

Do not use with any other chemical product.
